NKS YOUNG PEOPLES CLUB (YPC)

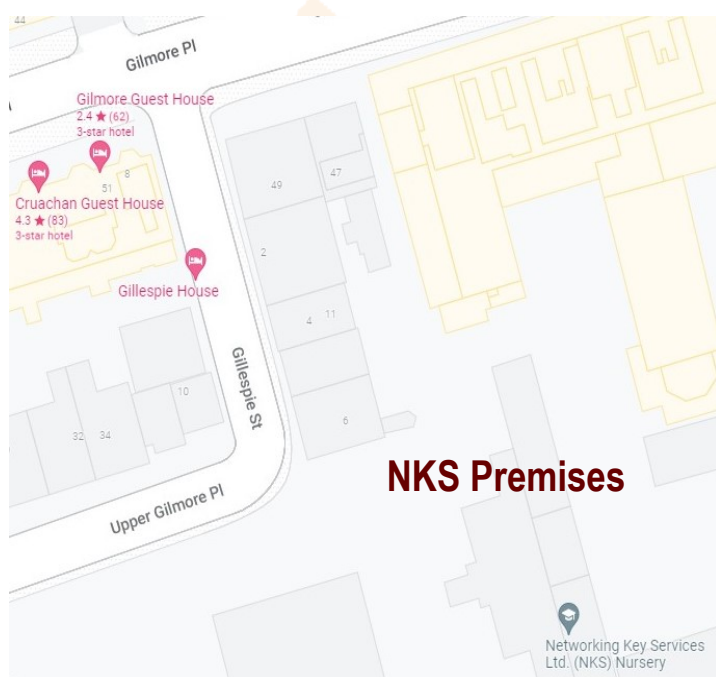

HOW TO FIND US



Bus numbers 27 and 10 go down Gilmore Place. Just get off at the second stop after King's Theatre. If this does not suit you then many buses go to Tollcross, in which case you should get off at King's Theatre and walk down Gilmore Place (away from the theatre). We are at the bottom of Gillespie Street which will be on your left hand side. The NKS signs will be visible.
