GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT NKS NURSERY

YOUR CHILD IN THE NKS NURSERY



The primary aim of the Childcare Facility is to alleviate deprivation and isolation among children and to provide them with an opportunity to develop a positive self-image within a comfortable environment.

There are two sessions per day:
8.30 am to 12.45 pm
1.00 pm to 5.30 pm

Fees are:

£13.75 per session, per child for over 2's (£23.65 for full day)
and

£17.60 per session, per child for under 2's (£33.35 for full day)

There is a 35p charge for snacks in the morning session. Afternoon snacks are provided by parents.

A deposit of 4 weeks is required at the start. This is refunded at the end.

If you are attending any of the sessions at NKS then childcare is free during this time.

However, you must book a place for your child in advance.

The Childcare Facility is registered with the Care Inspectorate and inspection takes place as required.
